




Two teams play against each other

1-3 persons form a team.

Every team plays with 6 balls.

Team A plays with white balls and Team B plays with yellow balls.





Only the winner team can record the score on the scoreboard after a played round.

Team A scores four points.

The team, which played the last ball, starts in the following round.

Team B starts in the second round.

1st round

Both teams play by turns all balls in the playing field until all 12 balls are played. It is allowed to touch the bar marks and other balls. The team with the most balls in the same target field wins the appropriate score.

Points rule

First, the number of balls will be counted and afterwards the score.

Four balls on a "1" field is better than three balls on a "2" field

A ball on the joker field can be counted as any number field.



Win of the first part of the game

The team, which scores at first 18 points or more, wins the first part of the game.

The winner of the first part starts in the next part.

A Cross-Golf play lasts two winning parts.

Instructions

<u>Team A</u> plays the first white ball



<u>**Team B**</u> plays the first yellow ball



2nd round

If both teams play the same number of balls in the target fields, the team with the higher score wins this round.


Three balls on a "3" field is better than three balls on a "2" field

Independent of the number of balls on the joker field.

Joker and number field points are equal

Balls in the fields of the other team do not count.





Team B has nine points

Points will be counted if a round ends with the same score of both teams.

If a team plays with a ball of the rival or a ball is played out of the field, the round will get interrupted and the rival gets 6 points.
